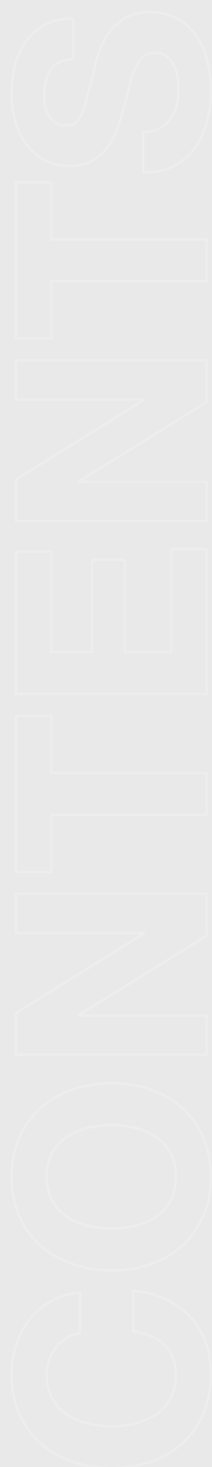


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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Ghana Library Authority declared 2021 as the Year of Literacy under the theme “Eliminating Learning Poverty through Public Library Services”. To achieve this declaration, the GhLA expanded its obligations to satisfy the demands of Ghanaians who patronize the Authority’s services both digitally and manually.

GhLA’s response to the COVID-19 outbreak was lauded around the world, winning two international awards in the process.

The Authority in the year continued to extend necessary lifeline to Ghanaians facing job losses and lacked the pre-requisite skills and certification through the Online learning project on scholarship dubbed Read2Skill, benefitted by thousands of Ghanaians.

Our 2021 performance can be analyzed based on five main key objectives:

- Increase reach of Literacy Interventions implemented by GhLA.
- Build capacity of School and Public Librarian in digital service delivery.
- Increase number of library resources available to patrons.
- Improved delivery of library infrastructure.
- Increase number of Libraries.

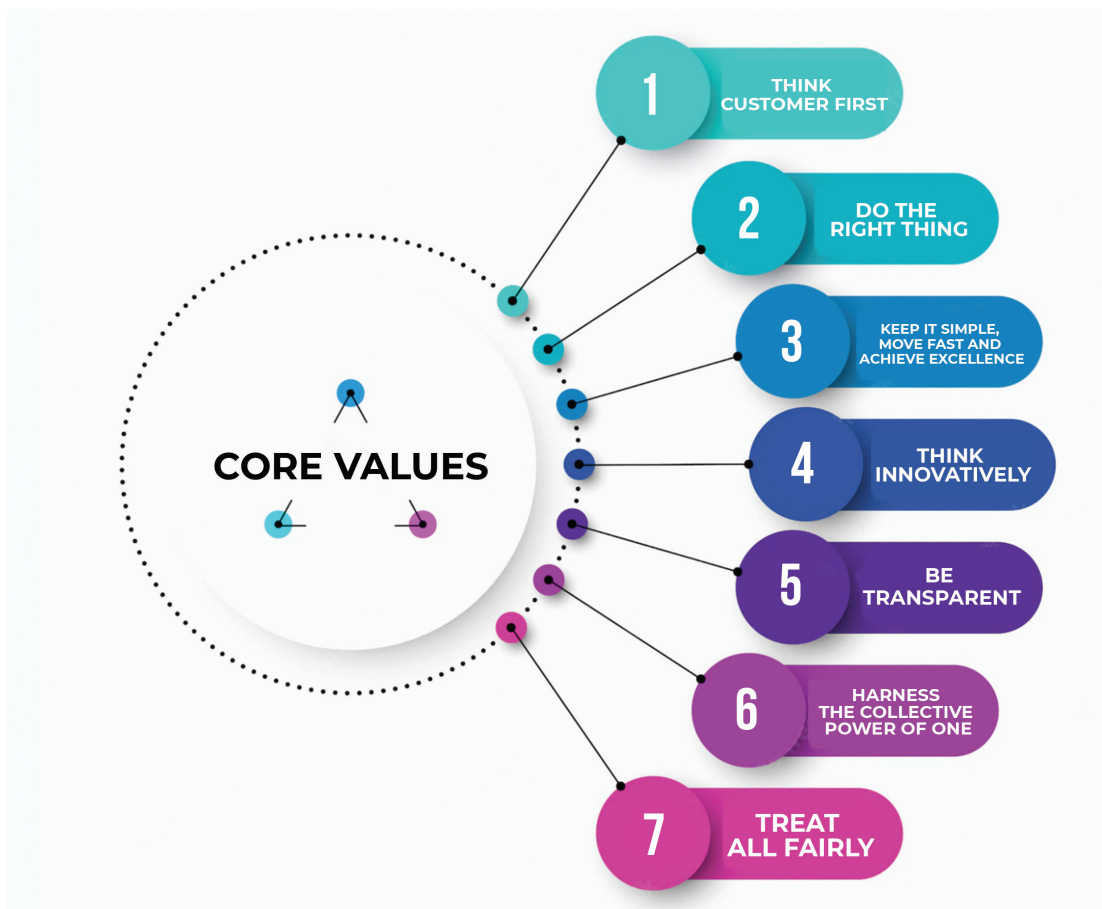

STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES FOR 2021

Objective 1: Increase reach of Literacy Interventions implemented by GhLA.

- 192 Personality Readings and contest were organized across the country.
- Established 430 reading clubs across the country.
- Mobile Library Visit
- Automation of the ISBN
- **Hands-on Mobile ICT Training** - expanded the mobile ICT Classes project to Forty-eight (48) schools. The GhLA through this project won a UN Public Service Awards in the category of “Fostering Innovation to deliver inclusive and equitable services for digital transformation”.
- Online Learning Courses (Read2Skill): 42,840 Ghanaians have been enrolled on Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) platforms such as Coursera and Udemy to study under full scholarships.
- 1078 Ghanaians have also been enrolled on the Absa ReadytoWork online learning platform.

Objective 2: Increase number of Libraries.

In 2021, we increased our network of libraries by 16, from 91 to 107. They are:

- Greater Accra Region – Nsakina Branch library.
- Central Region - Captain S.K Armah, Nana Neenyi Gyan II, Eugene Arhin Foundation Library & ICT Centre, Senya Bereku Library, Amosima.
- Ashanti Region - Kumawu Library.
- Oti Region- Dambai.
- Eastern Region - Janet Brako, Kodjonya Millennium.
- Upper West - Nandom Municipal Library.
- Northern Region - Lamashegu and Mandari library.
- Volta Region - Tapaman, Takpa Amanyanya and Kpetoe Agotime Library.

Objective 3: Build capacity of School and Public Librarians in digital service delivery.

A total of **291 public librarians** and **200 early grade teachers** were trained to deliver digital library services effectively.

**Objective 5:
Improve delivery of library infrastructure.**

Nine (9) libraries were renovated in 2021 Agbozume, Kpando, Jasikan (**Volta Region**), Lartebikorshie Grace Library, Accra Children’s Library (**Greater Accra**), Ashanti Regional Library (**Ashanti Region**), Jumapo Library, Koforidua Library [Adult section] (**Eastern Region**) and Gowire- Kunkua (**Upper East Region**).

REPORTS FROM DIRECTORATES AND UNITS (GHLA HEADQUARTERS)

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S SECRETARIAT

The Executive Director's secretariat is to provide efficient, effective and timely administrative duties for the Authority. The Secretariat has proper documentation of internships, training and workshops as well as details of staff that exited the Authority in 2019. A total of One Thousand, Five Hundred and Twenty Seven (1,527) letters were received this year and action taken on them by the Executive Director. Some of the letters came from the ten (10) Regional Libraries, Departments, Ministries, Organizations, etc. Ninety Three (93) letters were dispatched for the period, to the Ministries and other Organizations.

A sixteen (16) member board was sworn in at the Ministry of Education by the Honourable Minister of Education - Dr. Yaw Osei Adutwum on 24th September 2021.

Despite a few challenges faced, the Secretariat is still committed to ensuring efficient and effective administrative duties for the Authority with the necessary support needed.

HUMAN RESOURCE DEPARTMENT

The Human Resource department is in the process of completing migration of GhLA staff on to the new Scheme of Service. All the validation of monthly salaries was completely done within the Quarter. Thirty six (36) staff have exited from the Ghana library Authority (GhLA) payroll, reducing the strength to Five Hundred and Sixty Six (566).

The GhLA has received reviewed Salary Structure for new Scheme of Service to Fair Wages and Salary Commission.

The Authority embarked on the migration exercise in this period. We have recorded a total of Fifty eight (58) National Service Personnel and One Hundred and Four (104) Nation Builders Corps interns respectively in GhLA. All salary suspension staff have received their salaries from a long suspension from Audit Service.

CORPORATE AFFAIRS UNIT

The Corporate Affairs Unit is responsible for the positive image building of the Authority and provides the overall communication strategy and visibility for the brand. In 2021, the Unit produced the Back2School video for library patrons, produced videos on the Mobile Hands-on ICT classes, produced the internal spotlight series, produced videos on the virtual library management manual, produced videos on the early grade community reading intervention, and well as the senior high school library transformation projects.

The Unit in 2021, developed twenty-two (22) communication strategies, developed ninety-seven (97) creatives, drafted sixty-seven (67) press releases and syndicated fifteen (15) newsletters. By the end of December 2021, the Facebook followers of the Authority were 24,282; the Twitter followers were 2,054, the Instagram followers were 2,200 and the Linked In followers were 1,217. On media engagements in 2021, the Authority had ninety-nine (99) radio mentions, twenty-seven (27) print mentions, forty-four (44) TV appearances and fifty-six (56) online mentions syndicated across two hundred and eighty-nine (289) portals.

ESTATE UNIT

The Estate Unit is the facility and property manager of the Authority. In 2021, the unit supervised and executed many works and projects, including renovation of offices, remodeling office spaces, assessment and renovation of selected senior high school and branch libraries, routine maintenance, preparation of sketch and the compilation of assets register.

The Unit also spearheaded renegotiations between tenants/occupants of Library premises, addressed concerns from the Security and Transport Units as part of its oversight administrative responsibilities and the organization of periodic clean up exercises.

PROGRAMMES AND PARTNERSHIP UNIT

The Programmes and Partnership Unit oversees both local and International partnerships while driving the strategic overview and tactical details of projects and programmes. The Unit is also mandated to actively seek out partners and sponsors to supplement programmes and activities. In 2021, the unit managed eleven projects and maintained GhLA partnerships. ARTS AND ILLUSTRATION UNIT

The Art and Illustration department is responsible for all art and illustrations related to the Authority.

The work done in the unit in 2021 was categorized into six folds; embossment of the Authority's assets and properties across the Greater Accra Region which included Headquarters, the Greater Accra Central library, Edward Akufo-Addo library, Laterbiokorshie library, Nsakina Library and Okaikoi South Community library, embossment of printers, scanners and computers (monitor, system unit, keyboard, and mouse) for Senior High Schools, branding of Airport Mobile Library van and spraying of murals at the Edward Akufo-Addo library, Illustrations, organizing Creative Art lesson, compilation of embossed items.

In total, the unit embossed 1384 assets of the Ghana Library Authority.

PROCUREMENT UNIT

The Procurement Unit is responsible for undertaking and coordinating all detailed procurement activities at the Authority. This includes the various requisitions from user departments that are referred to the Department for action. They are committed to ensuring that goods, works and services of the right quality are provided for the User Departments. In 2021, members of the unit underwent training in Public Procurement and on the GIFMIS.

The Procurement unit amended the 2021 Annual Procurement Plan to reflect the Renovation of 10 Youth Engagement Centres and content hosting reformatting and uploading on digital repositories to support remote and distance learning in Ghana. Entity Tender Committee meetings were held to approve the above activities on September 10, 2021 and September 28, 2021 respectively.

For the year 2021, a total of two hundred and twenty-three (223) requests were approved for action, Action was taken on most of them.

ACQUISITION AND DISTRIBUTION UNIT

The Acquisition and Distribution unit provides the necessary verification and authentication of newly procured books which is intended to stock our libraries across the country. In 2021, the Acquisition department received a total of seventy-three thousand nine hundred and thirty-five (**73,935**) books from different sources including Book Aid International, The Rebecca Foundation, Bible Society of Ghana, UNICEF, Bridge Publication and Local Publishers. Seventy-eight thousand three hundred and five (**78,305**) books were sorted, counted and automated in the year under review.

A total of fifty-six thousand two hundred and ninety (**56,290**) books were distributed to the sixteen (**16**) regional libraries and Rebecca Foundation libraries across the country.

SCHOOL AND COLLEGE LIBRARIES DEPARTMENT

The School and College Libraries Department (SCLD) is responsible for the overall foresight of Senior High Schools Libraries in the country. They provide unhindered access to a broad assortment of data and educational resources to facilitate the learning procedure of Senior High School students. A total of forty-six (46) school library renovation works were completed in 2021 under the SHS Library Transformation Project.

TECH AND INNOVATION UNIT

The Technology and Innovation unit has the core function to manage and develop software, systems and network administration as well as have the oversight responsibility of GhLA's ICT hubs. In 2021, the unit conceptualized and planned out the development of the proposed Library Book Store application, automated office processes using the smart workplace, developed a KPI report submission portal, developed a digital attendance register and completed work on digital library App enhancement

Also, the Tech and Innovation team completed work on Integrated Library Management System (ILMS), organized staff training for use of internal online systems and developed a school management system to be adopted subsequently and used for the running of basic schools which is yet to be deployed, pending administrative processes.

STORES UNIT

The Stores Department is responsible for the issuance of purchase requisitions as and when the material is required. In 2021, the Stores Department received numerous items which will be spelt out in terms of books and other receivables. There was a total number of Nine thousand, Four hundred and Two (9,402) books received. The unit also liaised with the Acquisition and Distribution department to take custody of the Book Aid consignment totaling Fifty thousand, Seven hundred and Seventy-Five books were also received in the year of review.

In addition, the unit held weekly and monthly reconciliation was successfully accomplished, recorded zero theft, and responded quickly to requisitions to ensure the smooth running of activities within various departments and regions across the country.

PROCESSING UNIT

The mandate of the department is to ensure that all collections from the Acquisition and Distribution department are thoroughly and comprehensively processed for easy retrieval and use in public libraries across the country.

A total of forty thousand and twenty-eight (**40,028**) MARC entries were added in the Evergreen for Greater Accra Library and its branches for the year.

The department issued manual bulk accession numbers of one thousand (1000) donated children's books for Brong-Ahafo Regional Library.

A total of eighty-seven thousand, nine hundred and seventy-one **(87,971)** Books were duly processed for 2021. Refer to the table below for details.

THE GEORGE PADMORE RESEARCH LIBRARY ON AFRICAN AFFAIRS

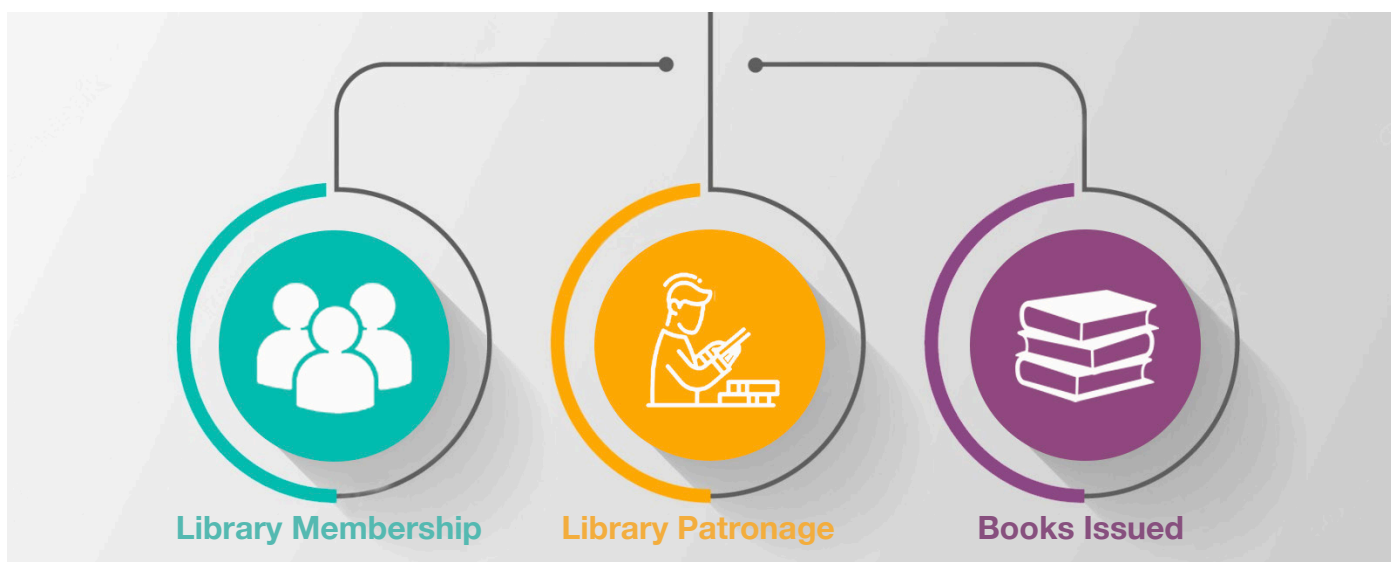
Dr. Kwame Nkrumah built the George Padmore Research Library on African Affairs as a memorial to the late George Padmore. The library collects materials on all aspects of African and Ghanaian knowledge. It also performs some functions of a National Library in the absence of one in Ghana.

In 2021, the George Padmore Library launched the online application of International Standard Numbers and CIP. In the year under review, one thousand one hundred and ninety-five (1,195) books were received as Legal Deposits. Also, fifty-three (53) books were donated to the Library. The Library recorded a total of five thousand six hundred and twelve (5,612) users. Ghana National Bibliography software was introduced to help hasten the compilation process since September, 2018. In 2021, the 2014 and 2015 GNBs were compiled and edited. Also, January to December 2021 GNB has been compiled and edited.

Over the reporting year, a total of 1964 single ISBN and 125 block ISBN were issued, 54 ISSN, 3 ISMN and 234 CIP were issued.

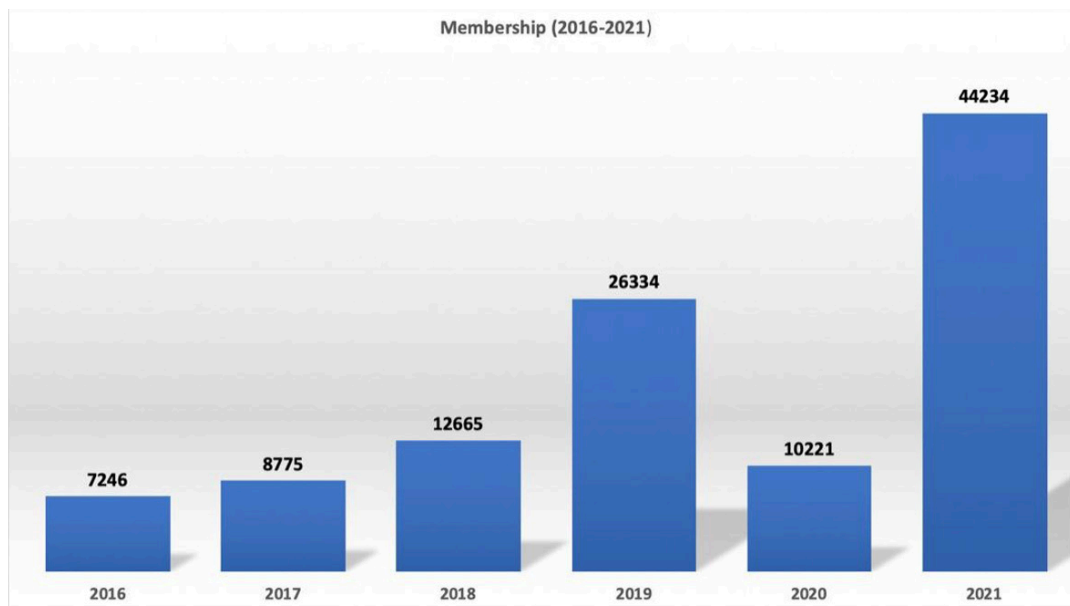

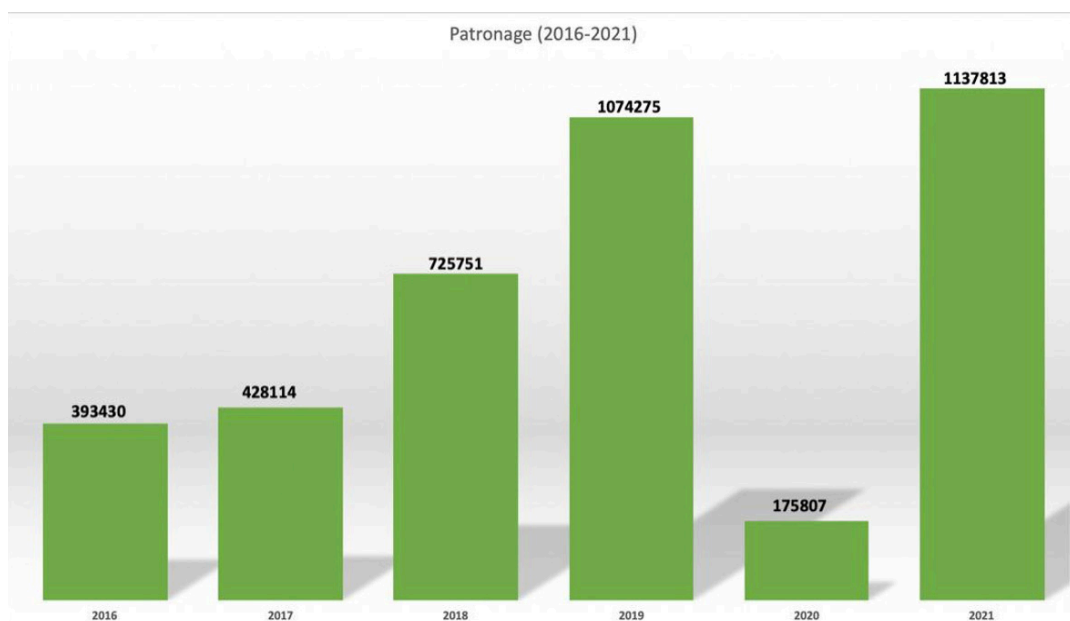
2018-2019: 107.90% increment in library Membership.

2016 – 2019: 173.1% increase in Library Visits.

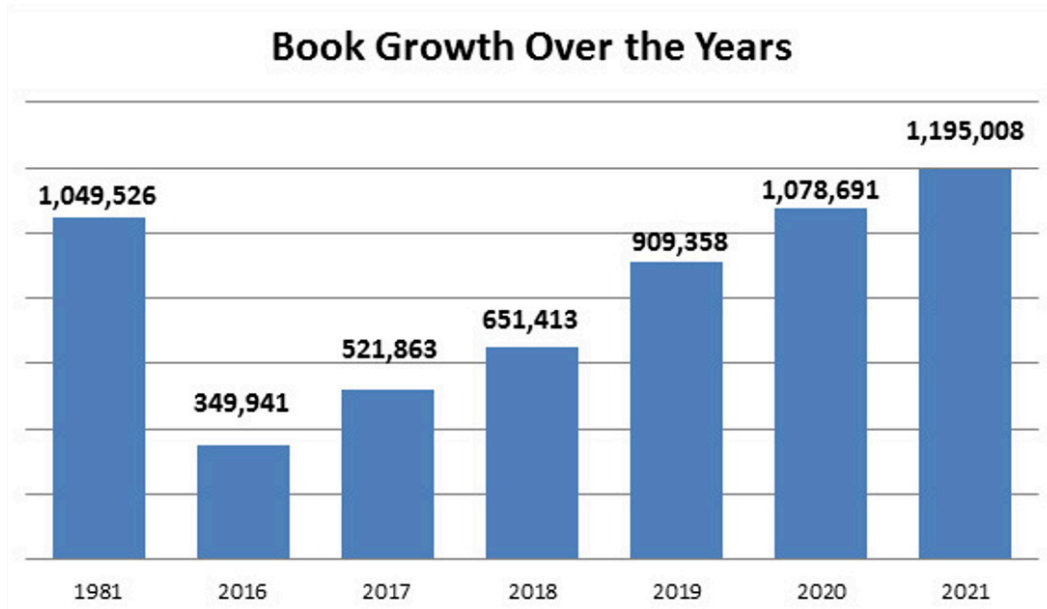
2018-2019: 48.10% increment in Library Visits.
